Care Instruction for PORCELAIN TILES FLOORING with Anti Slip R9

TI-30.2

– *cleaning, protection and maintenance* –
 Care instruction tested to DIN 51130

CONDITIONS

When treating a newly laid surface ensure sufficient drying time for the moisture to escape from the surface and substructure (maximum 2-4% residual moisture content).

Allow 2-3 weeks drying time for an adhesive bed and 4-6 weeks for mortar bed.

Drying times are indicative only and are subject to variation depending on the weather and the object and can be longer.

It's essential that any under-floor heating has been switched off and the surface is at a normal temperature, adequately cleaned, free of stains, dry and absorbent.

Always test in an inconspicuous place to determine suitability and coverage. Always read the labels carefully. Ensure the area around the surface to be treated is well ventilated.

CLEANING

Construction dirt: **R161 Porcelain Tile Intensive Cleaner** Coverage: approx. 10-80 m²/litre

Cement smears: **R163 Cement Film Remover** Coverage: approx. 5-50 m²/litre

Stains: Refer to Technical Information Sheet No. 1

After cleaning the surface must be allowed to dry for at least 1 to 2 days to a residual moisture content of 2-4% before any further treatment can take place.

PROTECTION – inside and outside

Basic protection: **S243 Porcelain Tile Impregnator** Coverage: approx. 15-30 m²/litre

Once dry the residual material is not harmful to health.

MAINTENANCE – inside and outside

Regular maintenance: **P315 Porcelain Tile Care Cleaner**
 add approx. 25 ml for every 10 liters of wash water

Periodical intensive cleaning: **R157 Ceramic Tile Intensive Cleaner**
 for keeping anti slip R9 means 20 times P315, than do a cleaning with soft brush and R157
